

## **ERASMUS POLICY STATEMENT 2021-2027**

The Vocational Training Technical Health School of Navarra ESTNA is a public center specialized in the healthcare professional family and, since 2009, recognized as a National Reference Center in the areas of healthcare products and services.

Currently five higher-grade titles are being offered by the Professional Health Family Oral Hygiene, Image for Diagnostic and Nuclear Medicine, Clinical and Biomedical Laboratory, Dental Prosthetics and Environmental Health, and one from the Family of Installation and Maintenance Risk Prevention Professionals.

The Internationalization, the development of mobility and cooperation actions in the field of Higher Education Teachings strategies are contemplated in the Annual Plan of the Center and in the Internationalization Plan.

ESTNA belongs to a Consortium of the Department of Education of the Government of Navarra through which it can carry out mobility for students and teachers.

To guarantee the objectives of the Erasmus program, the following activities are carried out:

- Dissemination and promotion of the call.
- •Selection of participants with transparency and equal opportunities criteria.
- •Organization of stays with foreign partners taking into account the professional profile of the students and the professional skills they have to develop, and the Training Agreement that guarantees the obtaining of ECTS credits is detailed.
- Establishment of measures that facilitate language training among participants.
- Promotion of the European Student Card Initiative
- Practical guidance for the trip and the stay in the host country.
- Monitoring of the stay to assess the Training Module in Work Centers.
- •Validation of the stays with the credits agreed in the Training Agreement, issuance of the Supplement to the Higher Degree and processing of the Europass certificate.

ESTNA is convinced of participating in cooperation projects or associations with other European institutions KA2 and availability to the reception of other Europe students.
